1	Irrigation Projects	Kaleshwaram Lift Irrigation Scheme (KLIS)	Dr. B.R. Ambedkar Pranahita Chevella Sujala Sravanthi Project was conceived by the then INC state government in 2007 with the estimated cost of Rs 40,300 Crores for diversion of 160 TMC of water from Godavari river to create ayacut of 16,40,000 Acres. The BRS government had re-designed the project in the name of Kaleshwaram Lift Irrigation Scheme (KLIS) in 2016 with cost overrun is by 110.59%, from the initial estimate of Rs. 40,300 crores to Rs. 1.40 lakh crores.	₹100,000.00	Backwater population: 1,87,404 PAFs: 70,886
2	Land	Dharani Portal	KCR and his family ensured that 24 lakh acres of private and government land in Telangana was listed as being under dispute. 5	Drinking Water	Mission Bhagiratha	The programme was designed only to take commissions. 6	Mining Lease	Allocation of Thadicherla coal block to AMR Mining	In 2011, the then INC CM Rosaiah had written to the SCCL to take up coal mining in Tadicherla coal block in Bhupalpally district. Due to SCCL's inaction and collusion with the BRS government and TSGENCO, the mine was allocated for a 30 years lease to AMR Mining company. SCCL reported that the coal deposit available at the mine to be substandard and under-reported the amount of deposits as 49.73 million tonnes, while in actual, the deposits are more than 80 million tonnes and quality of the coal available is of A grade.	₹16,000.00	3,63,00,000
7	Irrigation	Mission Kakatiya	In many instances throughout the state, works carried out under the scheme are marred with irregularities and corruption. As per a report on 145 tanks by CAG in Warangal district reported 65 per cent of works were not executed but 100 per cent bills were claimed by the contractors. Most of the contractors quoted 25 per cent less than what was estimated. But at the end, they got 40 per cent more. Irrigation officers were arrested in various other districts by ACB. 11	Land	Assets recovery post Nayeem encounter	BRS is shielding people involved in Nayeem's case. KCR government refused to handover Nayeem case to CBI. 12	Land	GHMC land allocation to a housing society	Following a "request" made by a senior state government official, through a recent memo 976/Assn.III(1)/2019, GHMC commissioner Lokesh Kumar sanctioned a layout for 32 acres in Survey No 327 paiki of Shaikpet village in favour of S.N. Mutually Aided Cooperative Housing Society (popularly known as Sakkubainagar). The GHMC commissioner's sanction came after its standing counsel submitted in the Telangana High Court that "according to the Municipal Corporation, Sy No. 327/paiki does not exist." Documentary evidence available with Deccan Chronicle revealed that different government agencies had taken a consistent stand for decades that Survey No. 327 paiki was a non-existent and fictitious survey number and that the only survey number available in the records — 327 — was government land. 14	Bank loan fraud	Madhucon Group Bank Loans	The Enforcement Directorate (ED) conducted raids on the offices of Madhucon Group in 2021, in the residences of K Srinivasa Rao, CMD of Ranchi Expressway, and the residences of its directors N Seetaiah and Nageswara Rao's son N Prithvi Teja in connection with a bank fraud case worth Rs 1,064 crore. Ranchi Expressway is an entity floated by Madhucon Infra to execute a contract of four-laning a 163 km stretch from Ranchi to Jamshedpur, awarded by the National Highways Authority of India (NHAI) to Madhucon in 2011. A consortium of banks led by Canara Bank agreed to fund Rs 1,151 crore, with a contribution of Rs 503 crore from promoters, towards the project. The Central Bureau of Investigation (CBI) had registered a case against Ranchi Expressway and its directors after a PIL was moved in the Jharkhand High Court and had also filed a chargesheet. The CBI found that the project had not progressed at all and the accused were involved in a fraud to obtain a loan of over Rs 1,000 crore	₹1,064.00	3,63,00,000
15	Procurement	TS MARKFED (especially Maize)	In 2019, the government through Markfed arranged 1.94 lakh tonnes of maize in the first phase, 2.09 lakh tonnes in the second phase and the remaining four lakh tonnes in the last phase. Documentary evidence revealed that Ranjith Reddy's firm Sri Rajeshwara Hatcheries Pvt Ltd lifted 51,150 MT and Noveltech Feeds Pvt Ltd was supplied 43,408 MT in the three phases.	₹1,000.00	56,59,890
